

Sub: Quota for Haj 2024 (Hijri 1445).

As conveyed by the Ministry of Minority Affairs, Government of India and as per Annual Bilateral Haj Agreement for Haj 2024 (Hijri 1445) between India and Saudi Arabia, a quota of 140020 seats for Haj Committee of India has been allocated. The quota allocated to Haj Committee of India has been distributed as per the Haj Policy 2024 for pilgrims among various States/Union Territory Haj Committees, as per the following details:-
